

Terms and Conditions:

1. Bring your own drinks including bottled water & food as well as cutlery, unless you cater from us. You have to bring your own wine glasses and champagne glasses. Please bring only non-glass wares.
2. Red wine and coconut based drinks are NOT allowed onboard as it will stain the floor if spilled. Durians are not allowed onboard as well. A deposit of \$300 will be required when bringing red wine onboard. This deposit will be returned back, provided no spillage occurs. If spillage occurs, the \$300 will be used as cleaning fees.
3. Bring your own ice to chill your drinks! Can be bought at the cold storage at the marina, subject to availability. There is a cooler box onboard.
4. No cooking allowed onboard. We have a microwave onboard which can be used for heating food but you have to bring microwaveable containers. Kettle can be used to make hot water.
5. We only have a mini fridge, so if you are bringing a birthday cake do not exceed 1 kg in size if you want to keep it in the fridge.
6. We have a karaoke system onboard with a wide selection of songs from a variety of different languages. However, if you want to bring your own songs, please bring them in thumbdrive form.
7. Please bring your own bait if you want to do some fun fishing.
8. Party poppers, balloons & confetti are strictly NOT allowed onboard. This is due to the marina's latest regulations against the use of party decorations on yachts. Failure to comply with this regulation would result in a penalty of up to \$500 which guests have to bear if caught by the marina.
9. If you are bringing young children, kindly keep them under tight watch for their own safety.
10. No need to bring a passport.
11. We only have life jackets for children from 5 years old onwards only. If you have babies and have much younger kids of below 5 years of age please arrange your own jackets.
12. Bring your own towels & toiletries (soaps, shampoos, etc.)
13. Sentosa island entry fee must be paid at toll gates by the charterer. Sorry we don't give out complimentary entry tickets for it.
14. Strictly NO SMOKING on board at all times!
15. Due to safety - No water activity or swimming allowed from 730pm.
16. No pets allowed.
17. Changes to the date of booking at least 6 days before your charter date will incur a \$100 admin fee. Changes to the date of booking 3-5 days before your charter date will incur a \$200 admin fee. Any change to date of booking that occurs less than 48 hours to original charter date is not allowed and will be considered as no-show; hence no refund.
18. For covid infections, only the person(s) who is covid positive or in isolation due to close contact cannot board the yacht and we will refund for that pax. The rest of the party will proceed as per normal. However, if you wish to postpone to another date, there will be a postponement fee of \$200 and the rescheduled date has to be within 1 month.
19. No refunds if lesser pax attend or for canceling any services booked and no offsetting of the amount paid for one service for the other.
20. In the unlikely case of an engine or any other mechanical failure we will postpone the trip and no refund for cancellation. In case of aircon, microwave, fridge or audio system failure we will still continue with the trip and there will be no postponement or refund or compensation of any kind.
21. In case of rain before the charter, the trip will be postponed for up to 30 minutes; if bad weather persists, guests will be able to reschedule at their convenience; no refunds for cancellations. If it rains during the charter, no postponement is allowed and no refunds will be given for unused hours. If it's light rain we will still go ahead with the charter.
22. Only if the haze exceeds 200 psi the customer has an option to postpone.
23. In the event that water activities equipment (e.g. fishing rods, snorkel kits, oars/paddles etc.) get lost at sea during use, charges will apply to replace them. For the fishing rod, it's \$100, for the snorkel kit, it's \$50 each and for the oars/paddles, it's \$150.
24. Sails will not be open in local charters within Singapore waters.
